going to continue to research your topic and answer the questions below. Remember, these are all going to build up to a research based outline. The more details you provide now, the more you will have to rely on later when you're putting it all together. Case: **Who** is involved in this case? (Be specific) What is being questioned? What are the stakes? Where is this taking place? When is this case happening? What is going on historically that may have an impact on this case? Who will be impacted directly by this case? Why? **Who** could be impacted long term by this case? Why?

Step 2: Now that you have done some research, it's time to think a bit deeper about each case. You need to think about why this case is important and who and what was directly impacted by the case. You are
